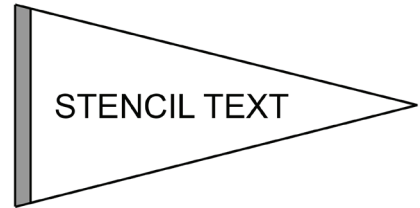

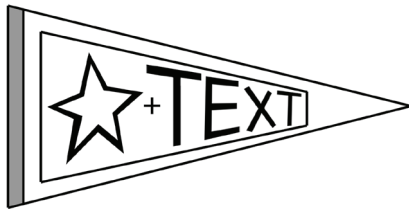

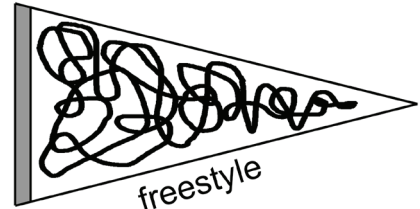

## For Pennants A & B

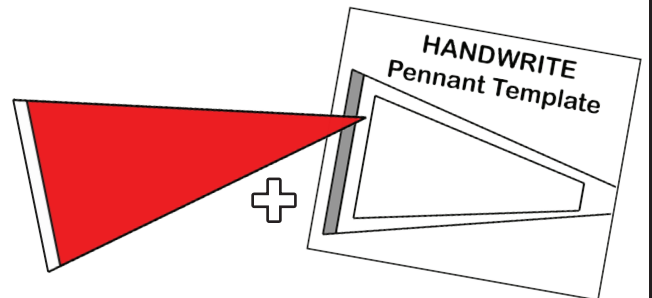
1

Select your word or phrase.

**BRAVE**

2

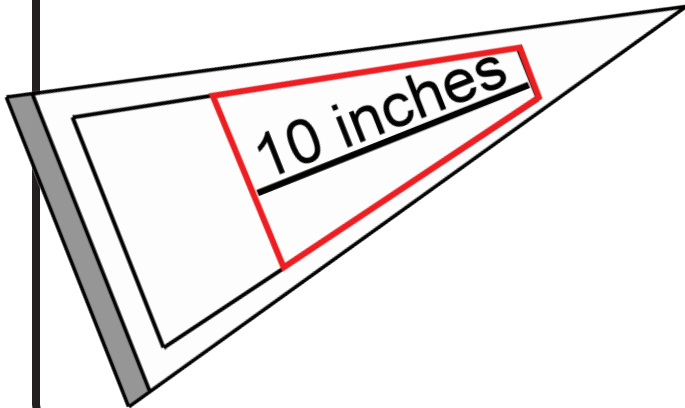
Grab a pennant and a paper template.



3

Decide how much space your word will take up on the pennant template.

Mark it and measure the length.



4

Count the number of letters in your word or phrase.



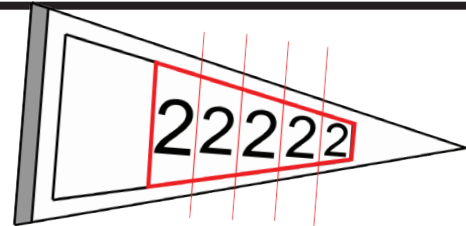
5

Divide the length of your marked template by your letter count.

$$10 \div 5 = 2 \text{ in.}$$

6

Draw vertical lines on your template to mark out space for each letter.



7

Now write one letter in each space. Fill up the space!



8

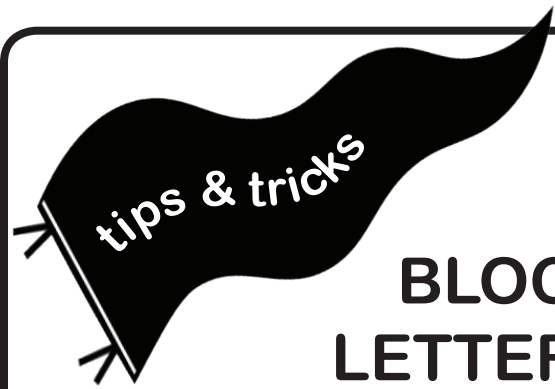
Cut out each letter from your paper template.



These will become your guides for the felt letters.

9

Pick out colors for your letters and images.

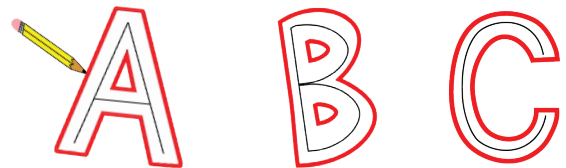


## BLOCK LETTERS

First, write your letter.



Next, trace around the edges of your letter, adding space in between.

Place paper letters (and images) on your felt, trace them, and then cut them out.



## FELT!

Check out the noun project for inspiration.



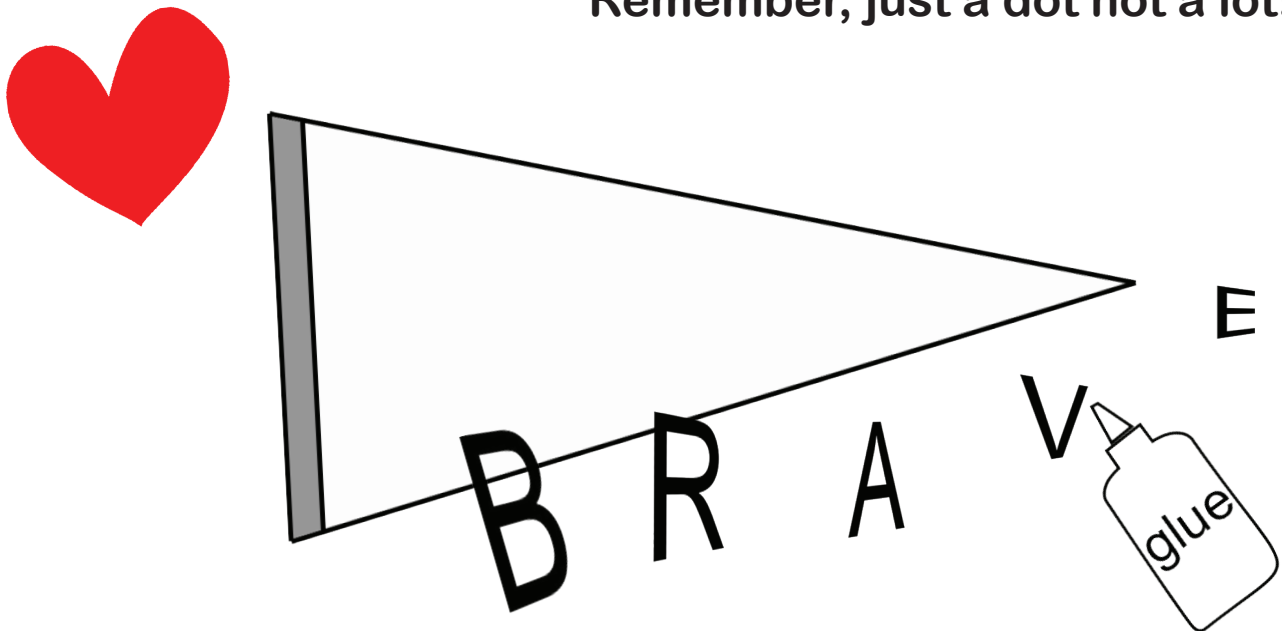
Worried about your traced lines showing?

Flip your guides so they are backwards on your felt. That way when you trace them, all your lines are on the back!

Once you are happy with the position of your shapes and letters, glue them to your base.

Remember, just a dot not a lot!
