GOALS FOR ARTS EDUCATION

Build upon our sustainable governance and communication structure for Any Given Child Bethlehem that supports arts education in Bethlehem Area School District elementary schools and middle schools by re-establishing data driven solutions groups. Ensure equitable access to the arts by providing every child a rich, community-based arts experience each year from Kindergarten through Grade 8. Pilot and evaluate the impact of a professional learning program that supports arts integration into the core curriculum with K-5 teachers. Evaluate the success of Any Given Child Bethlehem in meeting its goals by using common measures among the schools and arts community partners.

OUTCOMES

Content

- Provide increased and equitable exposure to music, theater, dance, and visual and media arts experiences for BASD students outside of their elementary classrooms, and inside their middle school classrooms.
- Develop guidelines and expectations using data-driven frameworks for teaching artists to deliver high-quality Any Given Child Bethlehem arts programming aligned to Bethlehem Area School District goals and operations.

Communications

- Establish social media platforms to inform, celebrate, solicit support, and align arts and educational resources associated with Any Given Child Bethlehem.
- Grow and maximize an independently-audited Any Given Child Bethlehem Budget for sustainable operations.
- Further establish a recognizable non-profit identity (pARTners) to coincide with the Any Given Child Bethlehem brand.

Assessment

- Align Any Given Child Bethlehem, the Bethlehem Area School District, and community arts partners' data measures and data systems to monitor and improve program outcomes.
- Use the Arts Vibrancy Index to benchmark the progress and success of Any Given Child Bethlehem.
