GOALS FOR ARTS EDUCATION

- Develop and leverage relationships with advocacy partners at the local, state and national levels to expand allies for both advocacy and direct services.
- Foster a network of partners and stakeholders to maximize the impact of advocacy for equity and access to quality arts education.
- Provide essential learning tools and curate authentic arts experiences for each student to fulfill their creative potential.
- Offer students rigorous programs that lead to a lifetime of engagement with the arts.

OUTCOMES

- Duval County voters approved the 2022 Ad Valorem Millage Referendum to dedicate and increase funding to enhance arts and music programs in DCPS schools.
- 100% of school board candidates in 2018, 2020 and 2022 agreed that expansion of the arts should be a top priority for the district.

Ensuring the Arts for **ANY GIVEN CHILD**

- Arts integration identified as a supported instruction strategy at the district level. Arts integration programs to expand by over 50% in schools.
- Partnered with the University of North Florida Data Science for Social Good Program to publish the Analysis of Arts Programming in Duval County Public Schools report.
- Four times the number of annual professional development opportunities provided to arts educators.
- DCPS Seal of Fine Arts awarded to graduating high school seniors for their outstanding accomplishments in the arts.
- Citywide arts education opportunities tracked through the Landscape of Education in the Arts in Duval (LEAD) and Jacksonville's artlook® map.
- More than \$17 million in arts-related scholarships awarded to DCPS students.
