We achieve our vision for arts education by centering equity, access, and inclusion as we champion arts education in our schools, promote arts education in our community, and work to ensure that all students receive a well-rounded education with the arts as a part of the core curriculum from grades k-12.

GOALS FOR ARTS EDUCATION

We plan to continue our expansion of artlook(r)oregon to include districts and schools in the region, and have already been able to focus on schools that lack any sort of arts education instruction to leverage that work with foundational support (PGF Foundation past grant.) This has enabled us to better understand the arts education landscape and have contracted with an arts advocate to put this vision into play.

OUTCOMES

We have increased our artlook(r)oregon capacity to nearly 300 arts and culture partners which create access and inclusion in our community, including our schools.
