- Galvanize the community and raise awareness of and support for equitable access to arts education

## OUTCOMES

- An overall 133% increase in public school student reach in arts and humanities education programming
- 92% of the schools we reached in the 2022-2023 school year have been Title 1 designated
- 95% of the teachers we have reached reported that our Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion implementation initiatives have been effective and noticeable in their student program experiences
- Over 50% of the students we reached in the 2022-2023 school year have been from DC's Wards 5, 7, and 8, which are historically underserved and underrepresented districts in our city.
- A comprehensive post-program assessment structure redesign that has led to increased student and teacher response (by 237% and 100% respectively), allowing our providers to have first-hand data to update and redesign their programs for relevancy
- A successful yearly surveying initiative that maps the overall landscape of the DC arts and humanities education sector to be used by our community for advocacy and funding support
- The launch of an online community platform for collective impact initiatives and committee meetings, with 106 registered users
